Scholarship recipient will be notified not later than July 2023. First payment of a \$2,000 scholarship award will be made in August 2023 and when proof of college enrollment at an HBCU is received reflecting a major in Education.

Subsequent payments of \$2,000 for years 2024, 2025, and 2026 will be made upon receipt of your college transcript no later than July of the award year reflecting a minimum of a 3.0 GPA along with proof of enrollment at an HBCU with a major in Education along with being a full-time student. If the student does consecutively maintain a 3.0 GPA in any given academic year, no additional scholarship award will be provided.

Scholarship

The Faye B. Bryant scholarship will be awarded to a 2023 graduating high school senior who will enroll for the first time in a four-year U.S. located accredited historically black college or university (HBCU) and major in education. The Scholarship award is based on three criteria: Academic Achievement, Leadership and Community Service. One \$8,000 scholarship will be awarded in \$2,000 increments paid for the first four years of college if a 3.0 minimum GPA is maintained each academic year and the student majors in education and attends an HBCU. Payment of scholarship awards shall be made payable to the recipient and the institution where the recipient has provided proof of enrollment. The scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books, supplies and other fees. The recipient must also be a full-time student.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a citizen/legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 or at least a 3.5 on a scale of 5.0, verified by a High School transcript.
- Must demonstrate Leadership abilities through participation in Community Service, Extracurricular or other activities.
- Must complete application online at <https://form.jotform.com/230466136702148> and upload all required forms: high school transcript, 500 word essay entitled “Why I Believe that Community Service along with Educating Our Students Are Important” and two letters of recommendation outlining the student’s leadership activities and community service by the deadline date.

School must email official high school transcript to fbefscholarship@gmail.com. Student name must be included in the email subject line.

Recommendation letter from a high school counselor, teacher, community leader must include his or her contact information (name, title, address, email, and primary phone number). A total of two (2) letters of recommendation are required.

The application must be signed on-line by both student and parent/guardian.

Completed Scholarship applications will be accepted through April 30, 2023.

There will be no exceptions to this deadline.
